Job Duties:

- Managing Division of Wildlife Resources' properties through weed control, fence and sign maintenance, and farming and irrigation.
- Monitoring, maintaining, and installing wildlife water structures/guzzlers.
- Monitoring habitat development projects through vegetation transects and photo-points.
- Transporting seed and equipment.
- Some weekend, late night, and overnight trips may be required.
- Work will be performed outside on a daily basis.
