



Master's position with the WI Cooperative Fishery Research Unit

Description and responsibilities: The Wisconsin Cooperative Fishery Research Unit is seeking an MS student to begin work January 1, 2018 on a project examining predator-prey interactions among walleye, yellow perch, and lake whitefish in Green Bay, which is a critical question for both the Wisconsin and Michigan DNRs. Project will require extensive field work on big water running a 22' whaler, substantial laboratory work (processing up to 3,600 diets) and analyses that will include bioenergetics models.

Qualifications: B.S. in biology, fisheries, or a related field

Salary: \$16,000 per year (2 yr) plus health insurance and tuition waiver.
