History of the Great Floods of the Colorado and Green Rivers

In a well-attended July 18 presentation in Moab, Vic Baker, Regents Professor of Hydrology and Atmospheric Sciences at the University of Arizona presented in-depth information on the history of flooding in Utah rivers. Baker has authored or co-authored 400 research papers and chapters and authored or edited 18 books on topics that include flood geomorphology and history/philosophy of Earth and planetary sciences.

A panel discussion followed the presentation, including Eric Kuhn, retired general manager of the Colorado River Conservation District and Kevin Wheeler, principal consultant for Water Balance Consulting.
