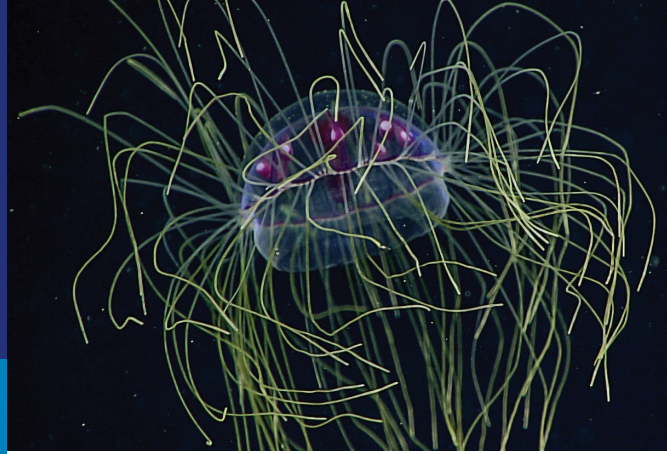

Eligibility

- U.S. Citizenship
- Currently enrolled students (undergraduate or graduate) or “gap year” students
- Degree, major, or intent to major in a field relevant to OER’s mission (e.g. science, technology, engineering and math fields, social sciences, communications, education, and ocean policy/management)
- Willingness to learn and follow OER standard operating procedures
- Students who identify with any of the following are strongly encouraged to apply: historically underrepresented in ocean sciences, including Black or African-American, American Indian or Alaska Native, Hispanic or Latino/a/e, female, first-generation college students, veterans, students with disabilities, and/or students who have experienced educational or economic disadvantages.
