

# Geography Teaching Minor

## GEOGRAPHY TEACHING MINOR REQUIREMENTS (19 credits)

A teaching minor in Geography **requires** an approved teaching major in another subject. All courses required for the Geography Teaching minor must be taken on an *A-B-C-D-F* basis. A grade of *C* or better is required for all courses taken to meet requirements for the minor. A minimum GPA of 2.5 is required for courses taken to complete the minor, but teaching licensure in the state of Utah requires a cumulative GPA of 3.0.
